On Thursday the juniors and senior classes are being welcomed to Club Aras where they will partake in a football blitz, 269 children in total. There will be 20 teams playing on the day, with 10 outside pitches being set up on the grounds in Magniers Hill. We have structured the playing activities on the day so that there will be 3 rounds of matches and all 3 rounds will take place simultaneously. First game commences at 10.45am, with a hooter to signal beginning and full time.

After the final round of matches, all children will be invited into the hall to have there lunch. BROOKES SUPERVALU has kindly provided us with some refreshments and fruit for every child on each of the 4 days. We are extremely grateful for the generosity shown by them, and wish to thank them most sincerely. The event will finish with certificates being presented to all pupils.

We have also arranged transportation to and from the 4 schools courtesy of BUTLER'S BUSES. Parents are also encouraged to get involved and come and watch the kids play, with teas & coffees will be available at the Clubhouse. We are delighted that the Camogie and Ladies Football will assist on each of the 4 days.


